

Village Ordinance No. 21

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE FURNISHING OR USE  
OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR BY PERSONS  
UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS

THE VILLAGE OF LAKEWOOD CLUB ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. Alcoholic liquor shall be as defined in the laws of the State of Michigan.

Minors: Minors shall be persons less than eighteen (18) years of age.

SECTION 2. ACTS PROHIBITED. No person shall knowingly sell, give or furnish any alcoholic liquor to a minor within the Village of Lakewood Club, except upon authority and pursuant to a prescription of a duly licensed physician.

No minor in the Village of Lakewood Club shall purchase or knowingly possess or transport any alcoholic liquor, or knowingly possess, transport or have under his control in any motor vehicle any alcoholic liquor unless said minor is employed by a licensee under the Liquor Control Act of Michigan and is possessing, transporting or having such alcoholic liquor in a motor vehicle under his control during regular working hours and in the course of his employment.

SECTION 3. VIOLATIONS. Any person found guilty of any offense under this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and/or imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety (90) days.

SECTION 4. Should any section or any part of this Ordinance be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days (10) after its passage and publication.
