

**VILLAGE OF LAKEWOOD CLUB  
TERMS OF OFFICE OF ELECTED OFFICIALS**

**ORDINANCE #33**

This Ordinance is intended to modify the statutory provisions of The General Law Village Act; Act 3 of 1985; Article 62.4, Sec.4; as amended January 1, 2005.

**Definitions:**

**Terms of Office:** The time that an elected official shall serve from the second Monday of September of the year when elected and until their successors are elected and qualified.

**Officer:** An Elected official for the village that serves in the capacity of President, Clerk or Treasurer.

**Trustee:** An Elected official for the Village that serves as part of the administrative board, but is not the President, Clerk or Treasurer.

**Section 1:** All terms of office for officers and trustees of the Village of Lakewood Club prior to September of 2007, set forth by the aforementioned statute are hereby amended as follows:

- A. All elected officials that are in office effective January 1, of 2005, with a term ending in March of 2006, shall hold their respective offices until their successors are elected and qualified by election scheduled for September of 2007, as amended by resolution #45.
- B. All elected officials that are in office effective January 1, of 2005, with a term ending in March of 2008, shall hold their respective offices until their successors are elected and qualified by election scheduled for September of 2009, as amended by resolution #45.

**Section 2:** All terms of office of officers of the Village of Lakewood Club after September of 2007, as set forth by the aforementioned statute are hereby amended as follows:

- A. Effective September of 2007, the duly elected President of the Village of Lakewood Club shall serve a term of four years and hold the respective office for the term of four years from the second Monday of September of the year when elected and until his/her successors are elected and qualified.

- B. Effective September of 2007, the duly elected Treasurer of the Village of Lakewood Club shall serve a term of four years and hold the respective office for the term of four years from the second Monday of September of the year when elected and until his/her successors are elected and qualified.
- C. Effective September of 2009, the duly elected Clerk of the Village of Lakewood Club shall serve a term of four years and hold the respective office for the term of four years from the second Monday of September of the year when elected and until their successors are elected and qualified. Until September of 2008, the Clerk's term of office shall not change.

**Section 3:** All terms of office of Trustee of the Village of Lakewood Club after September of 2007, as set forth by the aforementioned statute are hereby amended as follows:

- A. Effective September of 2007, three village trustees shall be elected at a biennial village election for the term of four years and shall hold the respective office for the term of four years from the second Monday of September of the year when elected and until their successors are elected and qualified. The term of office shall begin on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007 after the trustee's election and qualification.
- B. Effective September of 2009, three village trustees shall be elected at a biennial village election for the term of four years and shall hold the respective office for the term of four years and shall hold the respective office for the term of four years from the second Monday of September of the year when elected and until their successors are elected and qualified. The term of office shall begin on October 1<sup>st</sup>, of 2009, after the trustee's election and qualifications.
