

ORDINANCE # 40  
SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ORDINANCE  
FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION

The intent of this Ordinance is to provide for and regulate the collection and disposal of residential garbage, to levy and assessment for said service, and to assess interest on any delinquent assessments.

Section 1: This Ordinance shall take effect April 1, 2006

Section 2: The special assessment roll shall be levied in annual installments, due July 1<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year. The installments of the Special Assessment Roll shall bear interest at the rate of 8% per annum. The interest is to be payable annually on each installment due date.

Section 3: The assessment made in the Special Assessment Roll are hereby ordered and directed to be collected and the Village Clerk shall deliver the Special Assessment Roll to the Village Treasurer, with a warrant attached, commanding the Treasurer to collect the assessments in accordance with the directions of the Village Council and the Treasurer is directed to collect the amounts assessed as they become due.

Section 4: The Special Assessment District shall consist of all lands within the Village which contain a structure from which garbage may accumulate, further defined as follows:

- A. Any home within the Village that has an occupancy permit; whether occupied full or part time.

Section 5: Said assessment shall be pro-rated from the time the occupancy permit is granted until the close of the fiscal year on March 30<sup>th</sup> of each calendar year.

At the regular meeting of the Village Council on November 28, 2005 a motion was made by Bruce Hager and Supported by Jeff Woodland to regulate collection and billing for garbage collection
