Ordinance No. 45

SHORT TITLE:                   AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF LAKEWOOD CLUB TO INCLUDE REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE PRESIDENT AND TRUSTEE ATTENDENCE PAY.

THE VILLAGE OF LAKEWOOD CLUB HEREBY ORDAINS:

**Section 1.     Purpose.**

Election to the village council is a privilege freely sought by the nominee. It carries with it the responsibility to participate in council activities and represent the residents of the village. Attendance at council meetings is critical to fulfilling this responsibility. It is the purpose of this ordinance to define the compensation and attendance of village trustees. The village president and trustees shall receive compensation for attending the regular village monthly meeting which is to take place on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of the month unless otherwise posted. If the president or trustee does not attend the regular monthly meeting they will not be compensated for that meeting.

**Section 2.     Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.**

All Ordinances, or any section thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.     Effective Date.**

This Ordinance will become effective upon publication.
